# ALOCASIA

Affectionately known as Alocasia Polly, this dramatically adorned green and purple specimen is an exotic species that adores/commands attention while also being low maintenance and accessible.

**TEMPERAMENT:** Easy growing in the right conditions. Gets along with beginners as well as advanced green thumbs but **not cats or dogs**.



**LIGHT:** Likes bright spaces but not direct sunlight. Perfectly at home in humid bathrooms and kitchens.



**WATER:** Keep the soil moist and water regularly (usually once a week, depending on the temperature and humidity in your home). The Alocasia also thrives in high humidity environments, so keep it in a pebble tray with water or invest in a humidifier.



**PET FRIENDLY:** No. Alocasia is toxic to both cats and dogs.



**AIR CLEANING:** Tirelessly, day and night.



## SIGNS OF DISTRESS:

*Droopy leaves in winter*  
Growth slows so reduce watering.

*Spots on leaves*  
Alocasia can be sensitive to minerals in tap water. Use distilled water.
