## CALATHEA WAVESTAR

Originates from tropical regions in South America and features striking green and burgundy-purple foliage with curvy, undulating edges. This jungle floor-loving species opens its leaves during the day and folds them together as light decreases, hence the "Prayer plant" moniker.



TEMPERAMENT: Relatively easy to grow with the right light and water conditions.



LIGHT: Bright. Calathea likes bright, indirect light or partial shade and thrives in humidity. Keep in a sunny room out of direct sunlight. Regularly misting recommended.



WATER: Likes to be kept moist but not soaking wet. Water every few days or as soon as surface soil is dry with distilled or purified water.



PET FRIENDLY: Yes



AIR CLEANING: Tirelessly, day and night.
