PHLEBODIUM BLUE STAR

Native to rainforests in South America, these stunning green-blue ferns have rounded leaves that resemble giant animal paws. They thrive in low light conditions that mimic the jungle and like hanging out in humid spots like bathrooms and kitchens.



TEMPERAMENT: Easy growing for both beginners and experienced gardeners.



LIGHT: Low. Blue Star likes filtered indirect light (like in the rainforest) and shies away from bright direct sun.



WATER: Once a week. More during the growing season, less when the fern is on growing 'hiatus'. Check soil to make sure it's neither soaked nor dry. Water from the sides to prevent root rot. Regular misting recommended.



PET FRIENDLY: Yes



AIR CLEANING: Tirelessly, day and night.

Brown tips on leaves Plant is under watered and air is too dry.

Place plant in tray with stones and water to increase humidity.
